UNLESS I SHARE GOD'S LOVE


Unless I share God's love today, My words are meaningless and dead, For what I do speaks louder far Than any words I might have said.

Unless I love my fellowman And show it in the things I do, Unless I make Your spirit real, How can they see past me to You?


